What is PVSA?

Log at least 100 service hours on GivePulse by the submission date (Sunday April 24th, 2022)

SERVICE LEVELS

BRONZE: 100-174 HOURS

SILVER: 175-249 HOURS

GOLD: 250+ HOURS

If you've logged over 100 hours of community service between Apr 25, 2021 and Apr 24, 2022, you will earn the President's Volunteer Service Award issued by the White House. Report your hours on [GivePulse](#) by 11:59pm ET, Apr 24, 2022. Make sure you share the impact with the Community Partner. If you were in a course or a program, you are required to share it with the Nashman Center as well. [Email us](#) with questions!

1. Navigate to the community partner page through the explore button.
2. Click on the event you attended. If you did not attend an event, click on the green "Add Impact" button towards the top of the screen.
3. Add any additional information, like a brief reflection!
4. If you did this work with a student org, share your impact with them towards the bottom of the impact screen by searching by name.

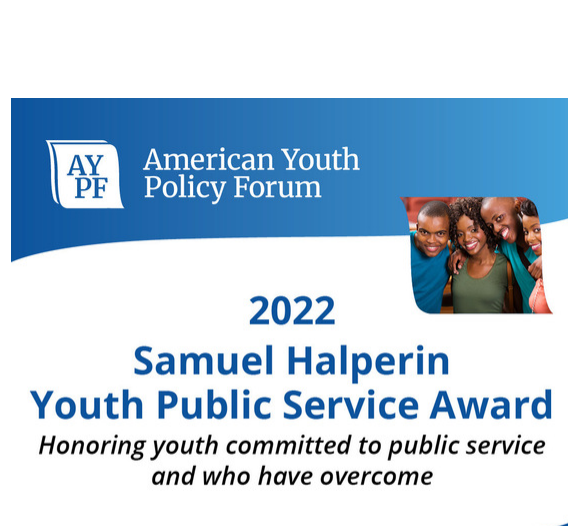

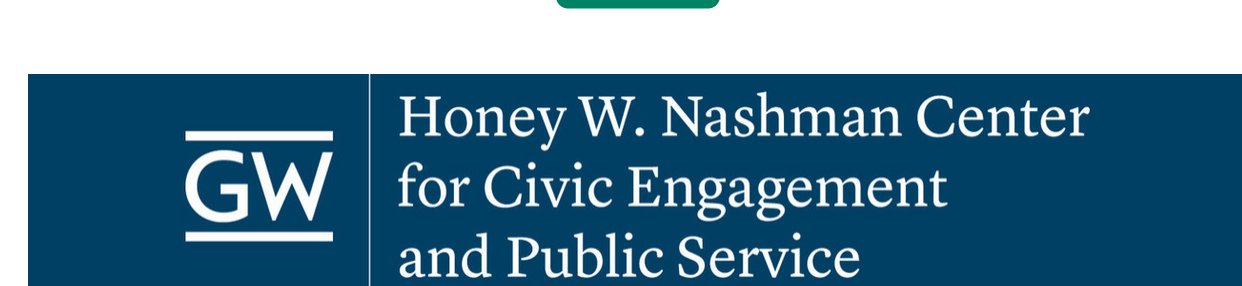
