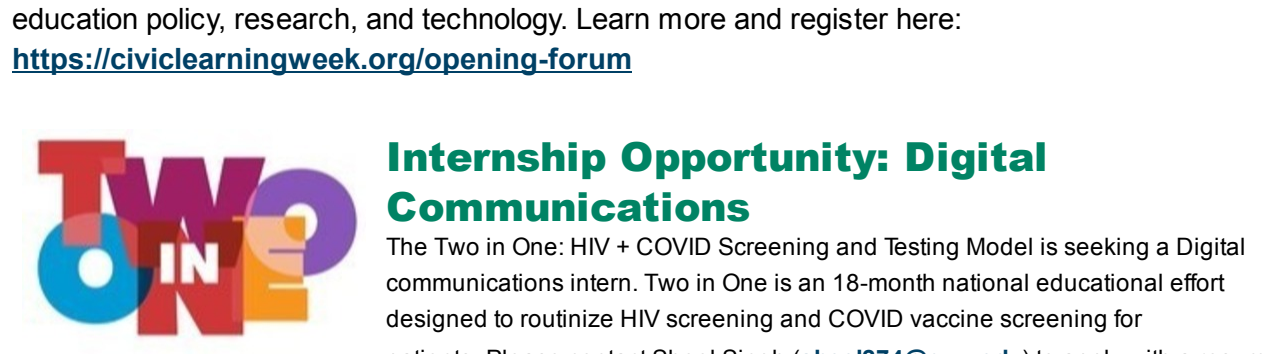

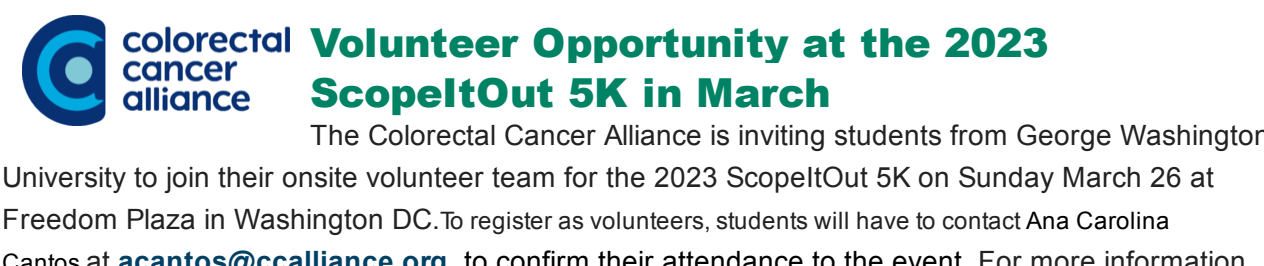


### **Attend the 2023 Civic Learning Week**

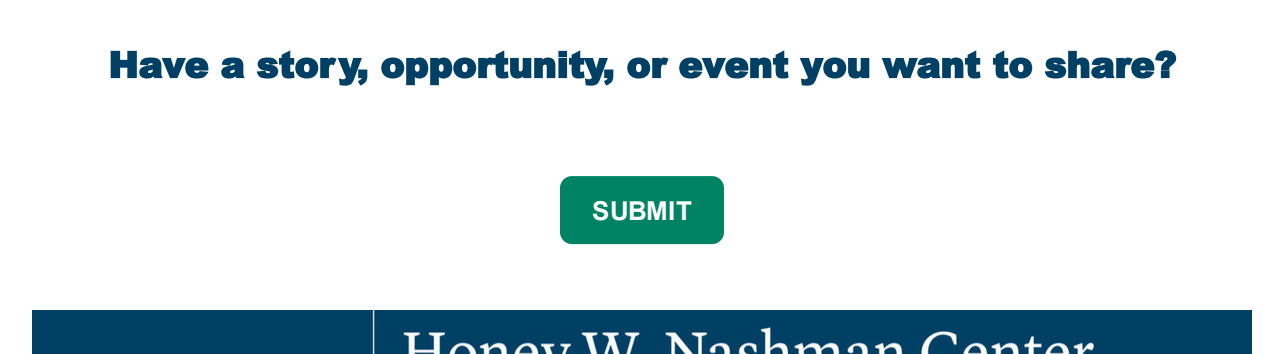
