Give-A-Gift!

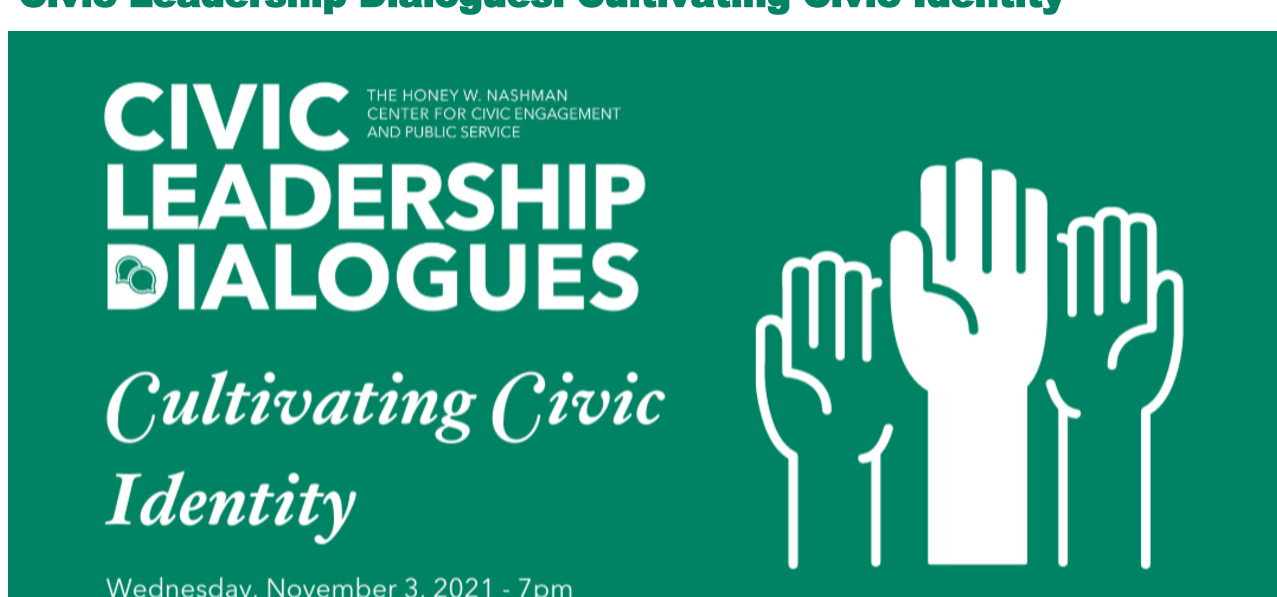
